

220 USE OF STUDENT RECORDS IN TRAINING PROGRAMS

Individuals in specialized training programs at the university level may have access to the confidential records of student's, provided the use of such records is supervised by a full-time, responsible employee of the school and permission for such use has been granted by the administrator directly responsible for such records.

Included within this regulation are the following training plans:

1. Student Counselor Program
2. School Psychology Interns
3. Student Nursing Program
4. Student Teaching Program
5. Administrative Interns
6. Individual research by candidates for doctoral or master's degrees when permission for such studies has been granted by the Oasis Academy administrator.
7. Any other training program sponsored by an acceptable agency when specifically authorized by the Oasis Academy's governing body.

Access to student records by individuals in training programs may be revoked at any time when there is evidence that disclosure of confidential information has been made by a trainee.
