

## **250 STUDENT DISCIPLINE**

State law charges every teacher and administrator with maintaining order and discipline among students; therefore, rules, regulations, and procedures are developed to establish and to maintain an orderly learning environment in each school. These rules, regulations, sanctions, and due process procedures are designed to protect all members of the educational community in the exercise in their rights and duties in all aspects of their experience, including participation in extracurricular activities, and interschool athletic competition.

The administrator has the overall responsibility for the discipline and welfare of students. Imposition of serious disciplinary action on any student, including, but not limited to, suspension or expulsion from school are governed by the sections of this manual titled 262 SUSPENSIONS and 266 EXPULSION AND LONG TERM SUSPENSION. These procedures are available in each school, distributed to teachers and students, and made available to parent(s) or guardian(s) upon request.

The primary responsibility for discipline in the classroom rests with the teacher, who shall use reasonable and professional judgment in maintaining order and in administering disciplinary measures.

The governing body of Oasis Academy has adopted written rules of behavior required of and prohibited for pupils attending Oasis Academy, as well as appropriate punishments for violations of the rules. Please refer to the section of this manual titled 252 SCHOOL RULES.

School organizations, clubs, and athletic teams may adopt and distribute to their members rules to govern student conduct which are in accordance with state and federal law, the policies in this manual and school rules adopted by Oasis Academy's governing body.
